Bexar County to Officially Open New Military and Veterans Services Center with a Grand Opening Ceremony on Veterans Day

WHAT: Bexar County will celebrate the opening of its Military and Veterans Services Center with

a grand opening ceremony this Veterans Day.

Funded by Commissioners Court in 2017 to ease the transition after military service, it aims to successfully integrate veterans and their families into colleges, work programs, employment, and more.

Elected officials and county staff members have already been working together with military leadership to implement this new program, but this new brick and mortar location will help facilitate its needs for staff.

The center's goal is to target service members who are within six months of leaving their branch of service to help better prepare for life outside the military, and ensure that veterans take full advantage of their benefits as they undergo this important change in their life.

The county's Veterans Service Office will also be moving to the new center's location and continue to provide exceptional service to our veteran community.

In addition, the county will be announcing the recipient of the 2018 LeRoy V. Greene Jr. Memorial Award.
